Message from President of the HKIS



It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to the HKIS Annual Dinner 2016. First of all, I would like to thank the Honourable Mr C Y Leung, Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and Past President of HKIS, to be the Guest of Honour. I am glad to share this joyful evening with all our distinguished guests, sponsors, members, and professionals from different sectors tonight.

Throughout 2016, the HKIS has achieved significant milestones in various aspects, progressing to strengthen our leading position in the built environment not only locally but globally as a professional organisation.

Fostering a Business-friendly Economic Environment

Surveyors continue to contribute ideas to promote the business efficiency and success of Hong Kong. The Institute has come up with four themes this year, namely: establishing a Lease Modification Section in the Lands Department to facilitate the better use of private land resources, using Independent Cost Consultants in Government Projects to enhance cost control, setting up of Building Repair and Maintenance Authority to facilitate building repairs and promote maintenance culture and developing Spatial Data Infrastructure.

A regular and foreseeable pipeline of government development projects is very important to the construction industry and the timely funding of the same is equally important. The Institute joined the Construction Industry Alliance to seek for timely approval for funding of construction projects in Legislative Council. We also call for the simplification of building plans approval under government lease so as to improve the efficiency of the development sector and also to make residential units to be made available early.

The Institute has continued to build up closer ties with employers of surveyors, both in the public and private sectors. Different events including gatherings, meetings and conferences have been organised so that we can exchange insights in the industry and business of the Institute with government departments, statutory organisations, private enterprises. Regular gatherings are held with various other professional institutes to exchange views and to pursue subjects of common concerns jointly.

Enhancing Surveyors' Participation in Government Policies

Members of the Institute are active in providing feedbacks to the Government in relation to policies and legislations which relate particularly to the built environment. To name a few, in 2016, we submitted our views to the Government on Registered Fire Engineer Scheme, Lantau Development, Arbitration (Amendment) Bill, Redevelopment of Buildings under the Civil Servants' Co-operative Building Society Scheme, and the Project Cost Management Office under the Works Branch of Development Bureau.

We also have set up three Policy Panels namely Building, Housing and Land to focus upon these areas and to come up with suggestions for the Institute to consider. Within this year, issues including ownership proof in support of general building plan submissions to the Building Authority, elderly housing policy, use of private land resources and CDA zoning.

Facilitating HKIS Development in Greater China

The Hong Kong Closer Economic Partnership Arrangement (CEPA) and Belt and Road Initiative have opened up many opportunities for surveyors. The Institute continue to steer partnerships with different professional organisation in China. Several delegations have travelled to Mainland cities including Beijing, Chengdu, Guangzhou, Shanghai, Shenzhen and Tianjin. Delegates met with different government and professional bodies related to the surveying sector, including the Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development, and the National Administration of Surveying, Mapping and Geoinformation, bringing the exchange of ideas, views and cooperation to the next level.

The HKIS has arrived into reciprocal arrangements with China Engineering Cost Association, China Institute of Real Estate Appraisers and Agents, China Association of Engineering Consultants. Many of our members have made use of their professional qualifications in China to promote and expand their business in Greater China.

Message from President of the HKIS

Promoting the Surveyors' Brand

The Institute has created a marketing plan and engaged a marketing firm to facilitate our branding initiatives and increase our public exposure.

Apart from sharing our professional insights and expertise with the Government, members also expressed their views in over 20 articles that were published in the columns of prominent local newspapers with positive feedback.

The Institute also proactively responded to various ad hoc social matters to demonstrate our professional skills and knowledge, including the collapse of rooftop at the City University of Hong Kong and 2047 land lease renewal concerns. The holding of press conferences, the prompt set-up of the BSD volunteer team, and the issue of statements on both matters helped to relieve the public's concern.

As part of the "Appreciate Hong Kong" Campaign, the Institute hosted the community campaign, "Touring Central with Surveyors 2016," for the second year. This event allowed participants to better understand the role of surveyors in the city's development cycle by visiting buildings with historical and economic significance. The highly successful event attracted a large number of public interest with 270 participants joining a total of 23 guided tours.

Riding on the success of the campaign, the Institute has published "Surveyors Serve Hong Kong," which is distributed during this special occasion. The publication showcases the achievements and contributions of surveyors based on a study of various landmarks in Central and supplemented by the commentary of senior government officials and professional surveyors.

Nurturing Young Leaders within HKIS

Different ways were explored to increase the exposure of our young members who will shape the future of our profession.

Young members actively participated in various committees and working groups and organised different events including study tour to Vietnam, annual dinner and drinks gathering which showed their devotion to the Institute. There have also been newspaper columns and interview dedicated to our young surveyors.

Improving Our Services to Members

We value our member experience with the Institute. One way is to stimulate idea exchange and communication.

Through enhancing our communication channels, messages can be disseminated more effectively to members. An archive has been developed to allow easier access to the Institute's records including its publications, reports and media coverage. A Wikipedia page for the HKIS has been enhanced and updated with new content to serve as a platform to increase the Institute's public stature.

Another effective measure which concerns most of our members is CPD events. The CPD check-out time has been significantly shortened due to the improved hardware system and enhanced building services. The increase in subscription fee was passed in the Extraordinary General Meeting which helps to facilitate the growth of the Institute.

Taking this opportunity, I would like to express my heartfelt thanks to all Office Bearers, members of the General Council, different Boards, Divisional Councils, Committees, Policy Panels and the HKIS Secretariat staff for their unfailing support and contributions towards the Institute's work.

會長的話



歡迎各位蒞臨香港測量師學會2016年周年晚宴。首先感謝香港特別行政區行政長官及前會長梁振英先生出席晚宴並擔任今晚的主禮嘉賓。同時亦很高興與各位來賓、贊助機構、會員及來自各界的專才共渡一個愉快的晚上。

回顧2016年，香港測量師學會在各個領域上均取得顯著成果，進一步加強學會作為專業團體，在本地以至全球業界的領導地位。

創造良好營商環境

測量師一直以來為香港的發展作出貢獻，致力提高商業效率。學會今年訂立四個主題，包括：建議地政總署轄下設置土地契約修訂組，有效運用私人土地資源；引入獨立成本顧問制度，加強公共工程項目的成本控制；設立樓宇維修工程監管局，推動樓宇維修和促進保養文化，以及發展空間數據基礎設施。

恆常和可預期的政府發展項目對建造業尤為重要，而及時的撥款亦同樣重要。學會加入建造業聯盟，要求建設項目在立法會的撥款申請能適時通過。我們亦建議簡化建築圖則審批程序，提升發展商發展樓宇的效率，令住宅單位盡早推出市場。

學會繼續透過不同的活動，包括舉行各種聚會、會議及研討會，與公私營機構主要聘用測量師的僱主建立更緊密聯繫，同時亦與政府部門、公營機構、私人企業等，交流及分享行業及學會最新資訊。學會亦與其他專業學會舉行恆常會議，探討共同關心的議題。

加強測量師參與政府政策

學會一直積極就業界相關的政策向政府提供專業意見。例如，在2016年，我們向政府就有關註冊消防工程計劃、大嶼山發展計劃、《仲裁(修訂)條例草案》、重建公務員合作社樓宇計劃，以及成立發展局轄下的項目成本管理辦事處等表達意見。

我們亦設有三個關於建築、房屋和土地的政策小組，為學會提供建議作參考。今年我們就有關建築圖則申請擁有權證明新規定、長者房屋政策、發展私人土地資源和綜合發展區等議題作出研究。

促進學會在內地的發展

「內地與香港關於建立更緊密經貿關係的安排」及「一帶一路」的發展策略為測量師帶來機遇。學會繼續與內地不同的專業組織建立夥伴關係，先後有多個代表團訪問內地不同的城市，包括北京、成都、廣州、上海、深圳和天津，與當地相關的政府部門及專業組織會面，包括住房和城鄉建設部、國家測繪地理信息局等，交換意見並商討擴闊合作層面。

香港測量師學會已與中國建設工程造價管理協會、中國房地產估價師與房地產經紀人學會及中國建設監理協會訂立了資格互認協議。不少會員取得內地的專業資格，有助提升和擴展他們於在內地的業務。

推廣香港測量師學會品牌

學會制訂了一套市場策略，並委聘了一家公關顧問公司，協助提升學會品牌及公眾認知度。

學會會員除了向政府表達專業意見，亦透過本地報章刊登超過20篇的專欄，闡述本會對多項議題的觀點，並得到正面的回響。

此外，學會更以專業角度，積極就有關土地、房屋及建築的突發事件作出分析及提供意見，包括香港城市大學屋頂倒塌意外和2047年地契續約問題等。我們亦透過新聞發佈會、成立建築測量組義工隊，就有關事件發佈新聞稿，運用專業知識釋除公眾的憂慮。

為響應「欣賞香港」運動，學會第二年舉辦「測量師帶你行街GUIDE」社區活動。是次活動讓參加者透過參觀有歷史和經濟價值的建築物，深入了解測量師在城市發展中的角色。學會舉辦了23個公眾導賞團，吸引共270人參與，受到大眾市民歡迎。

導賞團完滿舉行，學會亦出版了「測量專業建香港(Surveyors Serve Hong Kong)」刊物並藉今晚晚宴派發予各位嘉賓。刊物以多個中環的地標作研究，輔以政府高級官員和專業測量師的評語和見解，從而展示測量師的成就和貢獻。

培養學會年輕領袖

年輕會員是我們專業界別的未來棟樑，學會透過不同方式為他們提供更多機會，培養他們對專業的熱誠。

年輕會員積極參與多個委員會及工作小組，並協助籌辦不同的活動，包括越南考察團、周年晚會，以及酒會。此外，我們的年輕測量師亦參與撰寫報紙專欄和接受報章專訪，藉此向大眾推廣測量專業。

加強會員服務

學會對會員意見和體驗十分重視，期望促進彼此交流和溝通。

隨著改善學會溝通渠道，信息能更有效地向會員傳遞。學會新設立了資料庫，讓會員更容易查閱學會的記錄，包括刊物、報告和傳媒報導等。另外，維基百科有關香港測量師學會的頁面已經更新並且加入更多內容，有助提升學會的公共形象。

有關大部份會員關注的持續專業發展活動，隨著電腦硬件提升和會址的大廈服務改善，參加者就活動的等候時間已大幅縮減。而年費上調亦已在學會特別會員大會通過，將有利學會持續發展。

Introduction of the HKIS

The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors ('HKIS' or 'the Institute') was founded in April 1984 and had 85 founder members. The Institute was statutorily incorporated by virtue of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors Ordinance in January 1990 (Cap. 1148). In July 1991, the Surveyors Registration Ordinance (Cap. 417) was passed and a Registration Board was set up to administer the registration of surveyors.

The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors is the only surveying professional body incorporated by ordinance in Hong Kong. The Institute strives to maintain a high professional standard and requirements amongst members including setting standards for professional services and performance, establishing codes of ethics, and determining requirements for admission as professional surveyors. The Institute imposes a mandatory requirement for all members to upgrade skills through continuing professional development.

As a reputable and responsible professional body of surveyors, the Institute has always maintained vigorous assessment standards for entry to the profession and has also maintained high professional and ethical standards of member surveyors, through the various codes of professional practices, the code of ethics, and continuing professional development. The Institute has taken on an important and responsive consultative role in government policy making particularly on issues affecting land, property and construction. The Institute plays an important role from time to time in giving advice to the Government on issues such as land supply, unauthorised building works, building safety campaign, property management, town planning and development strategies, construction quality and housing.

The HKIS membership has now grown to over 9,000. As at 2 November 2016, the number of members reached 9,529, including 6,224 Corporate Members consisting of Fellows and Members – distinguished by the initials FHKIS and MHKIS; 74 Associate Members – distinguished by the initials AMHKIS; and 3,231 training grade members.

To qualify as a corporate member of the Institute, surveyors must possess a recognised academic qualification; complete supervised professional training within strict guidelines for a minimum period of 24 months, followed by an Assessment of Professional Competence (APC).

The title "Surveyor" embraces a number of disciplines involved with land and its development with land and buildings, covering an extremely wide scope. Some surveyors work in private practices and others may work for a landowner, developer, building contractor or government departments and related bodies.

The Institute consists of six divisions and one Young Surveyors Group:

1. Building Surveying Division
2. General Practice Division
3. Land Surveying Division
4. Planning and Development Division
5. Property and Facility Management Division
6. Quantity Surveying Division

A **land surveyor** measures and records the shape and position of the land, defines the boundary and sets out the legal boundaries of the sites. A **general practice surveyor** advises on the best use of the land, assesses the feasibility and viability of the proposed development project as well as the valuation, marketing, sale, leasing and management of completed developments. A **planning and development surveyor** further advises on the possible change of zoning, the likely environmental impacts and makes suggestions on preliminary development contents. A

quantity surveyor is concerned with the building contractual arrangements and cost control, and will evaluate the likely cost of the development project and advise on the most suitable kind of contract for the project. A **building surveyor** is involved in the project management of building development proposal, holistic maintenance management of building and overall control of private buildings under relevant legislation. A **property and facility management surveyor** provides a comprehensive range of services in real estate management.

The Institute has established and continues to expand its presence in the international scene through participation in various international platforms as well as reciprocity relationships with other national surveying bodies and through membership in relevant world bodies and international organisations to maintain its professional edge at international level. The Institute is one of the 3 founding members, apart from the Singapore Institute of Surveyors and the Institution of Surveyors, Malaysia, of the Surveyors' Alliance Asia which was inaugurated in November 2004.
