# The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors- Annual Conference 2022 "Northern Metropolis: A New Era of Hong Kong towards Sustainability, Resilience and Growth"

Hong Kong, 17 September 2022 - The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) hosted its Annual Conference today at Island Shangri-La, themed 'Northern Metropolis: A New Era of Hong Kong towards Sustainability, Resilience and Growth'. This year, the Annual Conference was conducted simultaneously in hybrid mode, which drew a record-breaking participation of over 600 industry professionals. Government officials, business leaders, industry experts and scholars were gathered together to explore forward-looking strategic planning of the sustainable development of the Northern Metropolis. The Honourable Paul CHAN Mo Po, GBM, GBS, MH, JP, Financial Secretary of HKSAR Government, and Ms Bernadette LINN, JP, Secretary for Development, Development Bureau of HKSAR Government act as the Guest of Honour of the Conference.

The Northern Metropolis Development Strategy announced last year at the Policy Address proposed to develop the northern part of the New Territories, covering a total land area of about 300km<sup>2</sup>, into a metropolitan area ideal for people to live, work and travel and foster the collaboration with Shenzhen through forming a spatial framework of 'Twin cities three circles.'

Many outstanding speakers shared their thoughts and insights on the metropolis and express their views on the possibility of its sustainable development.

During the Annual Conference, **The Honourable Paul CHAN Mo Po, Financial Secretary** of the HKSAR Government, congratulated the HKIS through a video message on the success of the Annual Conference, and expressed that he looked forward to the opinions and suggestions brought by the HKIS to the northern metropolitan area in the future; while Ms Bernadette LINN, Secretary for Development, Development Bureau of the HKSAR Government, shared the views on the development of Northern Metropolis and highlighted that it is the government's vision to develop the Northern Metropolis into an ideal place to live, work and travel, and enhance the cooperation between Hong Kong and Shenzhen to facilitate integration into the overall development of our country.

The annual conference was divided into three sessions, with ten industry leaders, experts and scholars sharing their insights on this topic. Speakers including **Mr CHAN Kar Lok**, **Walter, SBS, JP, Chairman of the Hong Kong Housing Society**, discussed about the 'Housing Development for Sustainable Living', while **Ir Patrick SIU**, **Chief Executive Officer of Hong Kong-Shenzhen Innovation and Technology Park Limited**, talked about "The



Loop: Pioneer in the Northern Metropolis' and **Mr LAI Chi Wah, Andrew, Director of Lands, Lands Department of HKSAR Government** shared the topic of 'Implementation of New Development Areas - Pioneer of Northern Metropolis'. These topics aroused enthusiastic discussions both on-site and online.

**Sr CHIU Kam Kuen, President of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors**, said, 'As surveyors, it is our responsibility to keep abreast of the development of the environment that we live in and constantly strive for improvement. This equips us with the knowledge and ability to deliver professional practices and services.'

Sr LAM Ka Fai, Francis, Chairman of the Annual Conference Organizing Committee and Vice President of the HKIS noted in his closing remarks, 'This conference outlines the current and future development of Hong Kong. Through mutual discussions, not only will we be able to develop the northern metropolis in a sustainable manner, but we will also be able to evolve into a resilient city with a new engine of growth.'
