The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors Annual General Meeting 2022 Inauguration of the New General Council

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) was held on 9 December 2022. Sr Paul WONG was elected as President of the HKIS for 2022-2023. Outgoing President Sr KK CHIU will assume his title as Immediate Past President to continue serving the Institute.

At the AGM, Sr Francis LAM was elected Senior Vice-President, Sr Robin LEUNG and Sr Tony WAN were each elected Vice-President, and Sr Raymond KAM and Sr Yvonne CHEU were elected Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer respectively.

The incoming President Sr Paul WONG is a Fellow Member of the HKIS. Currently the Director and General Manager of Tactful Group, Sr WONG has devoted himself to serving the surveying industry for over 34 years. Since 2008, he has held various positions at the HKIS, including the Chairman of Quantity Surveying Division in 2014-2016 and the Senior Vice-President of the Institute in 2021-2022. Sr Paul WONG has spared no effort in promoting the quantity surveying profession, cultivating talent and advocating for the wider application of BIM in the industry.

In addition, Sr Paul WONG has been actively engaged in various voluntary work related to the surveying profession. He currently counts membership in Manpower Development Vetting Sub-committee of the Construction Industry Council's (CIC) Construction Innovation and Technology Fund (CITF); Water Services Advisory Committee of the Water Supplies Department (WSD); and Civil Engineering and Built Environment Training Board (BCETB) of the Vocational Training Council's (VTC) Building. He has helped nurturing the next generation of surveyors and has advised universities on their curricula and examinations.

The incoming President Sr Paul WONG made some notable statements during the AGM: "With the gradual relaxation of Covid-19 prevention measures by the Government, Hong Kong has been making steady strides along the path to normalcy. We can foresee that the demand for professional surveying services will surge as



many major development projects will be implemented such as the Northern Metropolis, the railways extension and the Lantau Tomorrow Vision. The HKIS will continue to share insights with the Government on issues including housing and building policies, streamlining relevant procedures, adopting innovative technologies, and construction costs."

"It's among the aims of the Institute to nurture and encourage young people to join the surveying industry. We will continue to enhance professional development, talent training, community services, education promotion and professional services development, to fuel the growth of the Institute and industry,"

"The Institute will maintain its previous close ties with global and Mainland counterparts and organisations to promote the surveying profession in Hong Kong to the outside world and enhance its competitiveness."
